

Summary of Barriers among current enrollments.

Target goal: 26 youth.

Since the start of the new program year we have enrolled 23 youth, carried over 2 participants from 2018-2019 PY, and are in the final steps of enrolling an additional 4 youth. This would be a total of 29 youth.

The youth served have one or more of the following barriers: disability, poor work history, dropped out of high school, parenting, foster youth and/or homeless.

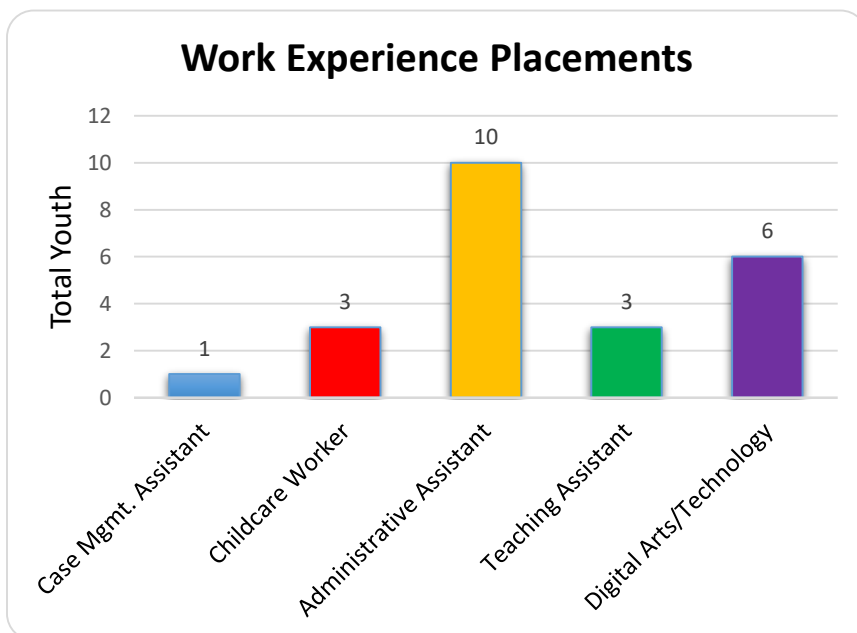
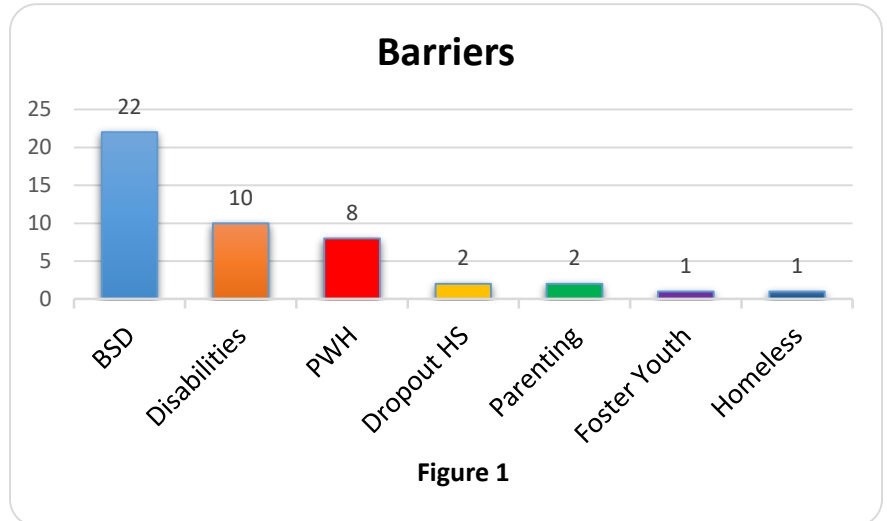

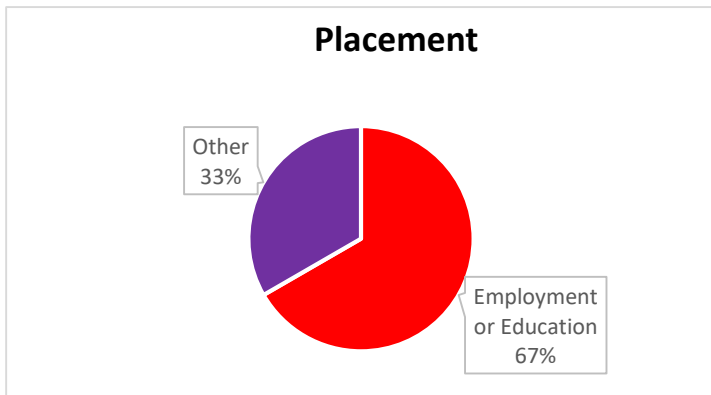
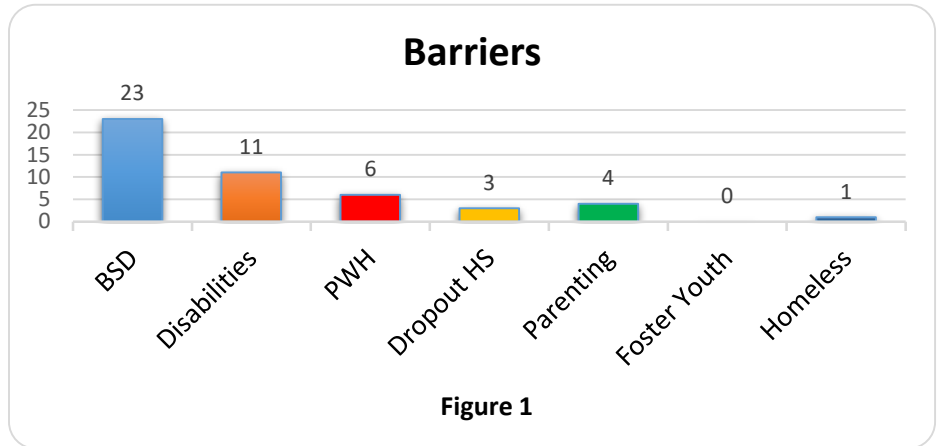
Work Experience Placement

- Digital Arts/Video Production

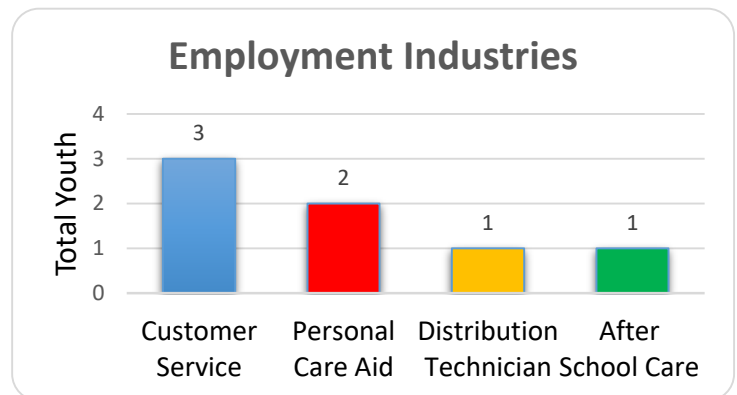
Summary of Barriers among 23 participants

Out of 23 participants enrolled during the 2018-19 year, 100% were basic skills deficient in at least one subject. The youth served had one or more of the following barriers: disability, poor work history, dropped out of high school, parenting, foster youth and/or homeless.



Placements

Out of 21 participants, 67% are either employed, enrolled in school or both. Fourteen participants are either working or currently attending post-secondary education and studying towards their career goal (Ex. Education/Teaching, Childcare, Nursing, Animation, and Social Work).



Employment Industries
