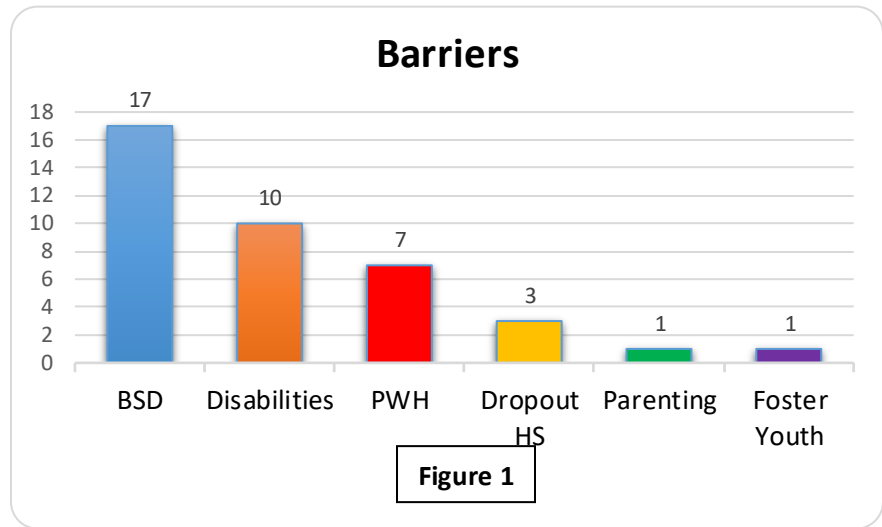
2020-2021 Follow-Up Summary

Summary of Barriers among follow-up enrollments.

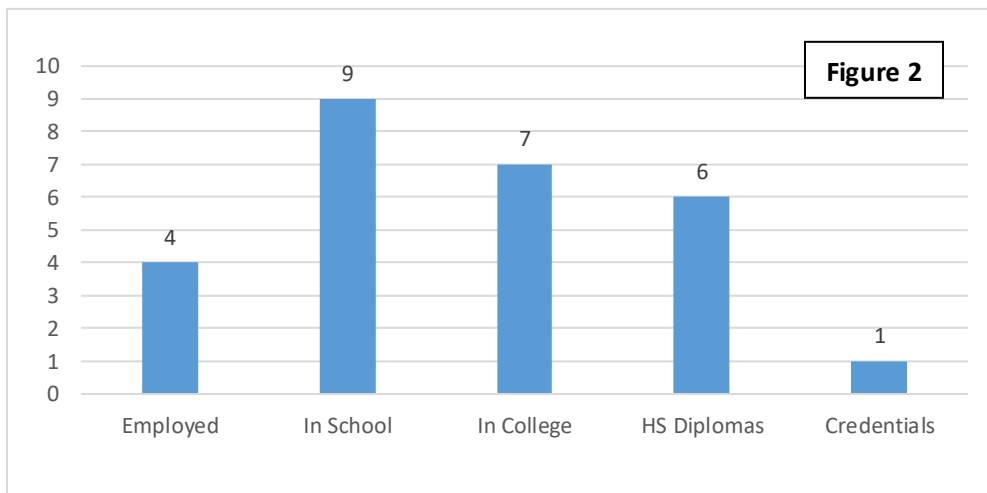
For the 2020-2021 program year, we enrolled 17 youth, 4 of which were carried over to this new program year, 2021-2022.

The youth served have one or more of the following barriers: basic skills deficient, disability, poor work history, dropped out of high school, parenting, and foster youth.

Work and School Placement Update

Out of the 17 youth, 14 are either employed or in school. Employed: **1 participant** is a front desk receptionist at OCCTAC; **1 participant is in** nonprofit @ OCCTAC's Wraparound Program, **2 participants in retail** @ Cotton On and Eco Town Thrift Store.

In terms of schooling, **9 participants** are attending school. **1 youth** is in high school and one youth recently graduated and will be attending Santa Ana College. **6 participants** are taking classes at Santa Ana College, **1 participant is enrolled** at a four-year university (Cal State Fullerton). Credentials obtained: **6 participants** have obtained their HS Diploma, **1 participant** obtained the general office clerk state certificate. See figure 2

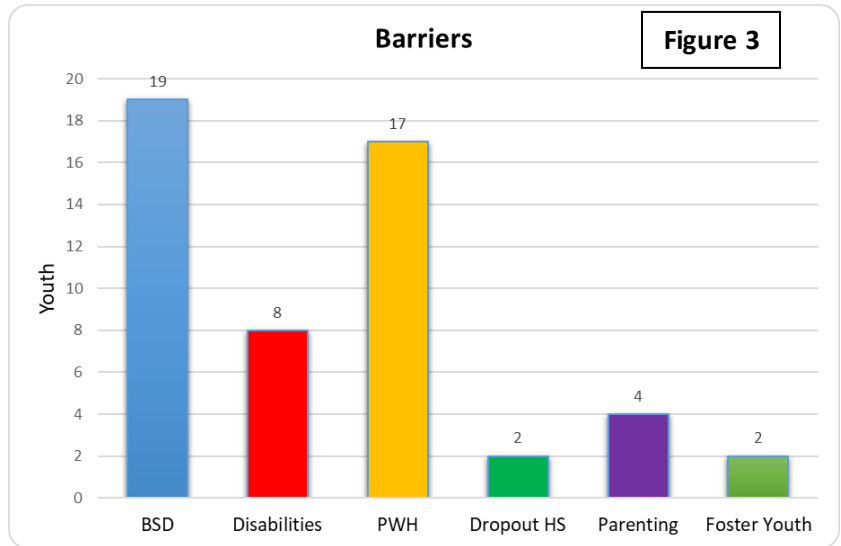
Summary of Barriers among current enrollments.

The youth served have one or more of the following barriers: basic skills, disability, poor work history, parenting, and foster youth. See figure 3

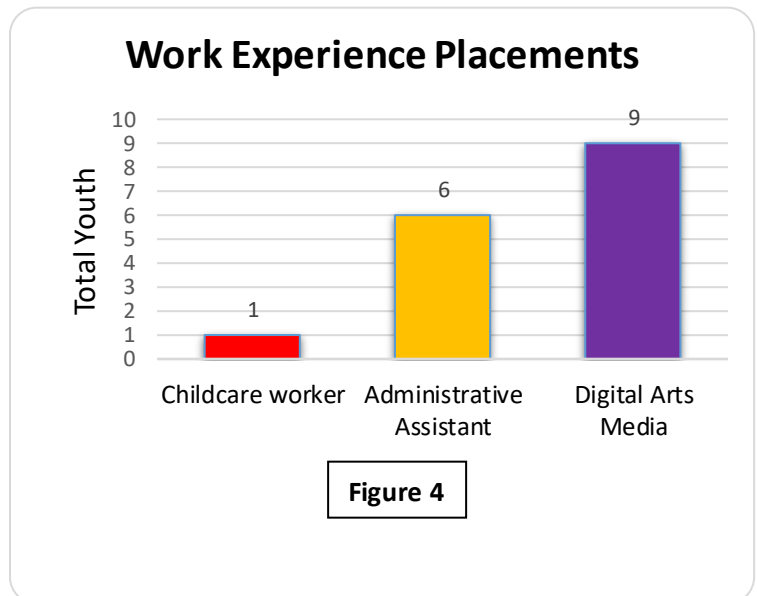


Work Experience Placements

Work and School Placement Update

Out of the 21 youth, 14 are either employed or in school. Employed: **1 participant** was employed at Walmart; **1 participant** was employed at Little Ceasers; **1 participant** was employed at General Logistics Systems, **1 participant** was employed at Ethika, **1 participant** was employed at a Logistics company.

In terms of schooling, **10 participants** are attending school, **3 youth** are in high school, and **1** is enrolled in continuation school, **5 youth** are enrolled in community college (**2** at Golden West, **1** at Santa Ana College, **1** at Sadelback College and **1** at Santiago Canyon College) and **1 participant** will be attending a four-year university (Cal State Fullerton). Credentials obtained: **2 participants** have obtained their HS Diploma, and **1 participant** obtained the forklift certificate, and **2 participants** have credentials in process.
